

AF 85 mm f/1.8 Nikkor	4 (F4)	This lens is unusual in having focusing carried out by the rear lens group, hence its RF (rear-focusing) designation. RF is a variant of the IF principle that combines features from the floating element approach (CRC) known from wide-angle designs. This helps give the lens good optical quality even up close. The 85/1.8 is a nice lens despite its awful cheap-looking plastic exterior, and capable of producing sharp and contrasty images from f/4 to f/11.
